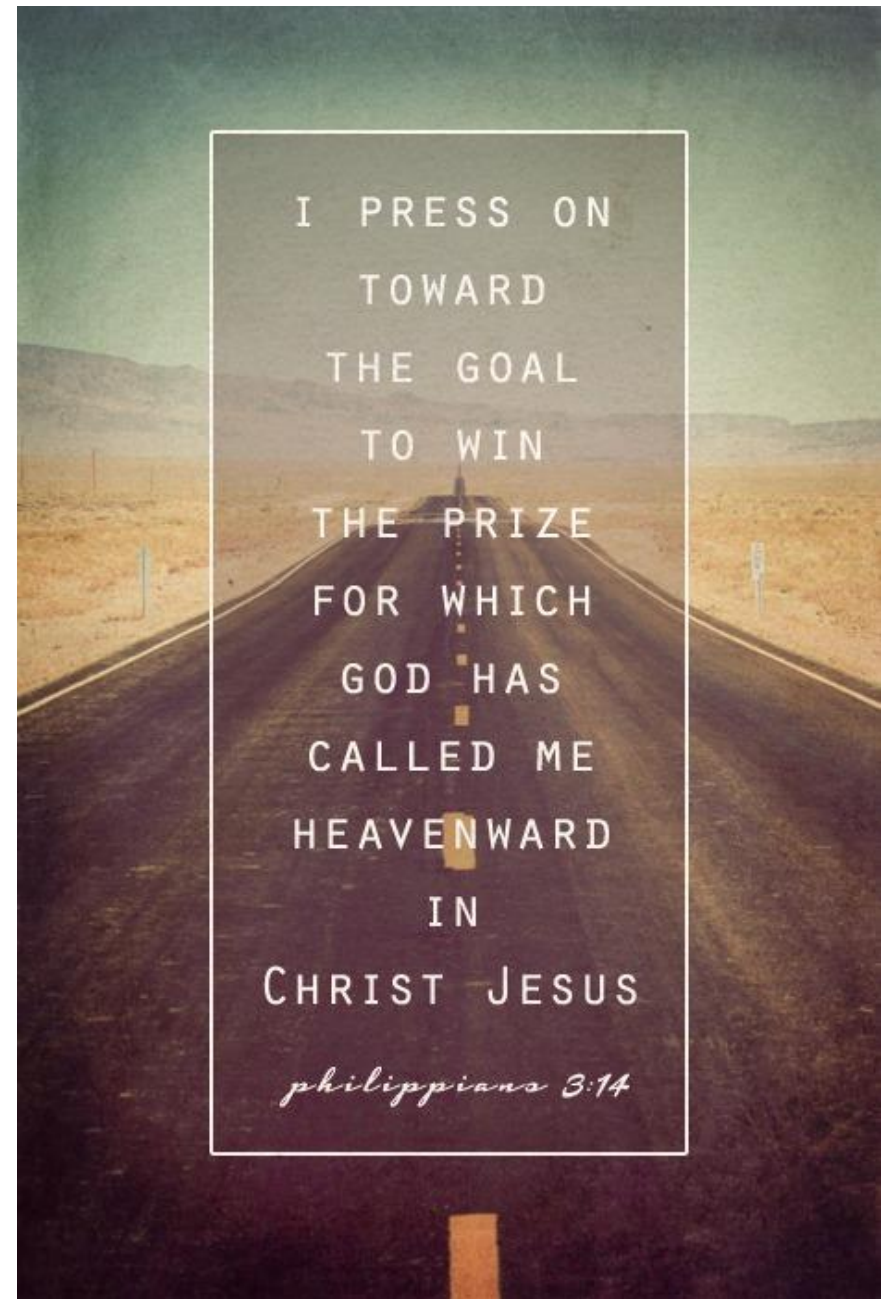
Philippians 3:1-4:1
