

## Who is God - Part 11 - God is Holy

- I. The Holiness of God
- A. Definition - God is pure, blameless, and flawless in all of His \_\_\_\_\_ and is set apart from His creation
- B. When we truly look at the Holiness of God:
1. We are impressed and \_\_\_\_\_ (Ex. 15:11)

- II. God's holiness revealed (Isa. 6:1-4)
- A. Isaiah sees God (Isa. 6:1)
1. God seated on the throne – God is \_\_\_\_\_ ruling over His kingdom
  2. High and lifted up – Refers to God's position in relation to everything else. God is high above \_\_\_\_\_
  3. The train of His robe filled the temple – God is Kings of kings there is \_\_\_\_\_ like God or \_\_\_\_\_ than God
- B. Isaiah sees the seraphim (Isa. 6:2)
1. Seraphim means “to burn or burning one” - This describes their \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ for God
  2. The seraphim had six wings
    - a. Two wings covered their eyes – Showing their humility and \_\_\_\_\_ to be in the presence of the holy God
    - b. Two wings covered their feet – Showing they were \_\_\_\_\_ serving their holy master
    - c. With two wings they flew – Showing they are ready to go and do as God \_\_\_\_\_
