- I. Job's wealth (vs. 3a)

- II. Job's family (vs. 2, 4)
- A. Job had 7 sons (which was often consider a sign of \_\_\_\_\_) and 3 daughters
  - B. There were no \_\_\_\_\_ in the family
- III. Job's Character (vs. 3b)
- A. He was a great \_\_\_\_\_
  - B. He was unusually \_\_\_\_\_
  - C. Other traits that made him great
    - 1. He was well \_\_\_\_\_ (29:7-11)
    - 2. He was a \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ judge (29:12-17)

- IV. Job's relationship with God (vs. 1b, 5)
- A. He was blameless – “without \_\_\_\_\_ blemish” or “\_\_\_\_\_ whole”
  - B. He was upright – “straight” in the sense that he did not deviate from God's \_\_\_\_\_
  - C. He feared God – He was aware of God, \_\_\_\_\_ God, and submitted to God
  - D. He shunned evil – did everything in his power to reject anything that is the opposite of God's \_\_\_\_\_
  - E. Job offered burnt offering on behalf of his children in case they \_\_\_\_\_ have sinned or cursed God in their hearts
